# **FORMAT**

**Title** in 15 words or less, capital letters, **Abstract:** in less than 250 words including problem, objective, methodology and results + key words. **Full paper:** Papers presented will be submitted to a blind review **process** using standardized criteria by external readers for inclusion in the Conference Proceedings 6-10 pages. (not mandatory to submit paper for publication). Typing: Arial 10 points, 1.5 space, margins: upper and bottom 2.5 cms.; right and left, 3 cms.; letter format, Word processor MSWord/OpenOffice. References following APA 2016, citation index.

Abstracts: February 15, 2018; Notification of acceptance: February 28, 2018

Full paper (for publication): March 15, 2018
