PARTICIPATION IN THE EVENT

You can participate as a lecturer, speaker or participant without a presentation.

- Lectures: up to 40 min (invited personalities on key topics).
- Presentations: up to 15 min.

Registration to participate in the event will be made by email addressed to the coordinators of the Conference. Those interested must include in their emails: names and surnames, institution of origin, country and email.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PRESENTATIONS

Those who are interested in participating with a presentation must fulfill the requirements established in the following section:

Title: in less than 15 words in sustained capital letters.

Data of the author and co-authors: Names and surnames, position, scientific or researcher degree (if any) and specify if you are an undergraduate student, institution where you work or study, country, ORCID and email.

Languages: Presentations can be made in Spanish, Portuguese or English. The proposal must be submitted in the language in which it will be presented.

Summary: up to 250 words where the problem, the research objective, the partial or final results are reflected, as well as the keywords (up to 5 words). The texts that are delivered in Portuguese and Spanish must present the abstract in English. Those that are in a language other than Spanish must be accompanied by a summary in this language.

Format: texts written in Times New Roman 12, line spacing 1.5; margins: top and bottom: 2.5 cm right and left 3 cm; letter format, Word processor MS Word / Open Office or PDF. Bibliographic reference: according to the APA standard, seventh edition.

Length: between 15 and 25 pages.

The organizers of this event express their gratitude to those presenting papers, the free permission to publish papers and participation. Those who agree to this request will specify it in their abstract. Selected articles will be published in the Santiago Magazine of the Universidad de Oriente, Cuba. The memories of the event will be published by the publisher Conciencia Ediciones of the University of Holguín.

Deadline for sending presentations: July 20th, 2022

REGISTRATION FEES

The tuition to be paid directly in cash at the time of accreditation for participants is:

- Foreign participants with presentation: 200.00 Euros
- Foreign students 100.00 Euros

- Foreign participant without presentation 180.00 Euros
- Virtual participation: 50 Euros
- National participants 5000.00 CUP.
- National students: 2500 CUP.
- Virtual participation for nationals: 350 CUP

The registration fee guarantees participation in the Conference sessions and other activities planned within the framework of the Conference, as well as the right to receive the corresponding certificate of participation and authorship of the work presented. The conference will have an interpretation service from English to Spanish and from Spanish to English in plenary sessions only.
